A NEW MURAL BY BOB LARSON

Artist Robert Larson, noted for his spectacular nature paintings and habitat back-ground scenes for many Illinois State Museum exhibits, has recently completed a new mural for the Illinois State University Library in Normal, commissioned by two ISU alumni.
